

## Ceacht 6 *Ar Scoil/In School*

### In this lesson you will learn how to:

- \* Address the class and direct the pupils.
- \* Name the main features of a classroom.

### Nóta:

Like in many other languages, there is a distinct plural form of 'you' used in Irish when addressing more than one person.

Maith an fear.	Good man.
Maith an bhean.	Good woman.
Maith sibh.	Good on you. ( <i>plural</i> )
Tabhair dom do leabhar, le do <b>thoil</b> .	Give me your book, please.
Tabhair dom an <b>chailc</b> , le do <b>thoil</b> .	Give me the chalk, please.

### The verb To Be

Beidh mé anseo amárach.	I will be here tomorrow.
Ní <b>bheidh</b> mé anseo amárach.	I will not be here tomorrow.
An <b>mbeidh</b> tú anseo amárach?	Will you be here tomorrow?

<b>Ól</b>	<i>drink</i>	<b>D'ól</b>	<b>Ólann</b>

### *Note the following:*

Taobh istigh      Inside  
Taobh amuigh      Outside

Istigh              In (Stationary)      Tá sé istigh.      He is inside.  
Amuigh             Out (Stationary)      Tá sí amuigh.      She is outside.

Isteach             In (Movement)      Tá sé ag teacht isteach.      He is coming in.  
Amach               Out (Movement)      Tá sí ag dul amach.      She is going out.

Amach leat!      Out with you! (*singular*)  
Isteach libh!      In with you! (*plural*)

**An Aidiacht Shealbhach = focal a chuireann seilbh in iúl.**  
*The Possesive Adjective = a word that expresses possession*

Mo chóta	My coat
Do chóta	Your coat
A chóta	His coat
A cóta	Her coat
Ár gcótaí	Our coats
Bhur gcótaí	Your coats
A gcótaí	Their coats
